Meeting Minutes

The St. Tammany Parish Fire Protection District No. 13 Board of Commissioners met in regular session at 7:00 PM on May 19, 2021, at the St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 13 fire station located at 13053 Hwy 190 Covington, LA 70433.

Minutes Review: Review and consideration of approval of the April 21st, 2021, board meeting minutes, Mr. Devillier made a motion to approve minutes, seconded by Mr. Cortez, no further discussion, all in favor. (See attached).

Financial Report: Board Secretary Clint Ory discussed and reviewed the April Financial report, noting that a \$308,913.69 repayment on collection of Ad Valorem was required due to an error on inventory tax from the Louisiana tax commission. Despite this error the budget is on target in collections and expenditures. The completed Financial Audit was introduced and will be adopted by resolution next month. The April credit card report was also submitted to the board and was found to be in order. Mr. Devillier made a motion to adopt the financial reports, and credit card reports, second by Mr. Voelkel. No further comments or discussion, all members in favor (see attached).

Old Business

- 1. Chad Danenhower reported on the status of the land acquisition for Station 134. The Champagnes have approved the additional needed land (1.44 acres) with a few stipulations still to be worked out. Additionally, they have been provided proposed elevation drawings.
- 2. Chief Johnson reported that repairs to Station 132 by contractor are complete, the station is being prepared to move back in, finishing kitchen appliances, etc.
